### The Indigenous Language Landscape of New Mexico.

This module will present information about the critical nature of Native language survival and what this means for tribal communities and Native American students attending New Mexico public schools. It is intended to raise a consciousness and an appreciation of the unique strengths and link to cultural survival, as well as the current challenges facing Native language communities in maintaining and preserving their languages.

### Pueblo Studies Curriculum: A Microracial Approach to Addressing Racial Micro- and Macroaggressions.

This module is designed to provide an overview of racial micro- and macroaggressions in social studies curriculum and to present a curricular response as a racial microaffirmation. Participants will gain insight on a critical race analysis of curriculum and become acquainted with the Indigenous Wisdom social studies curriculum as a practical but critical response.
